DID YOU KNOW?

Nebbiolo is a thick-skinned grape. When the grapes are pressed, this leads to a high ratio of skin to juice, creating high-tannin wines with bold structure.

ABOUT THE REGION

Santa Barbara county is a high-elevation region recognized as one of the coolest growing climates in California. The moderate temperatures yield exceptional growing conditions where grapes can ripen fully on the vine while preserving juicy acidity.


