ABOUT THE WINE

The 2021 Lucas & Lewellen Moscato comes from old vine grapes grown in the Don Miguel vineyard, where rocky-clay soils, cool temperatures, and a long growing season yield powerful Moscato. The old vines lead to fruit with concentrated flavor, creating an aromatic and complex wine. This exceptional bottle is a compelling example of the merits of dry Moscato. This wine is bursting with citrus and stone fruit aromas and full of mouth-watering acidity.

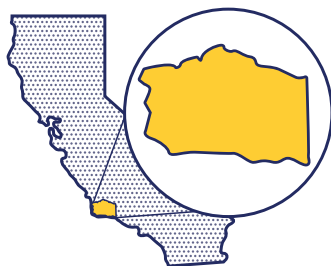


DID YOU KNOW?

The muscat family includes over 200 types of grapes. Some varieties of muscat can be eaten as table grapes or dried into commercial raisins.

ABOUT THE REGION

Santa Barbara County is carved up into several smaller regions, each with microclimates and soils that suit specific red and white grape varieties. All of Santa Barbara, however, experiences warm days and cool nights from Pacific Ocean winds blowing inland. This results in the grapes developing vibrant, fruity flavors that carry over to the wines.

This dry moscato is like a bouquet of flowers in a bottle. Look for lush floral flavors of white flowers like gardenia, along with lemongrass, peach and nectarine, all with a backbone of refreshing acidity.

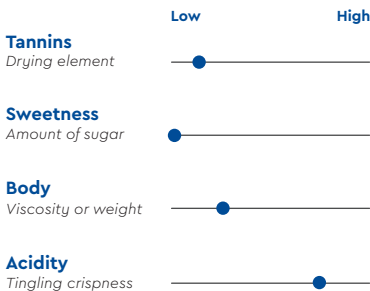

TASTING TIP

Although it's full of ripe fruit flavors, this is a dry wine. Off-dry wines are distinguished by the presence of residual sugar, which results in a thicker, sweeter wine.
