


DID YOU KNOW?

Pink wines are made from red grapes. To create a rosé, winemakers press red grapes and use a shorter maceration time. The color and structure of rosé comes from red wine skins.

ABOUT THE REGION

The Yakima Valley AVA is nestled within the Columbia Valley in Washington. It's the state's oldest wine-growing region. It's known for producing high-quality wine grapes, and is suitable for nearly every variety, red or white. It's essentially high desert, with a long growing season of warm days and cool nights—and virtually no crop infections or pests.

This rosé bottles up the best flavors of summer. Ripe berry flavors dominate the nose and the palate. Refreshing acidity makes it hard to stop at just one glass.


